

MÜLLER THURGAU SOLARIS

Vigneti delle Dolomiti
FRIZZANTE



IGT VIGNETI DELLE DOLOMITI.

The growing area comprises the provinces of Trento, Bolzano and Belluno, where the Dolomites surround the vineyards.

GRAPE VARIETY

This semi sparkling wine is produced with Müller Thurgau grapes and Solaris, which grow on the area closed to the Adige River. The vineyards are situated at 400 – 700 m. above sea level.

WINEMAKING AND SECONDARY FERMENTATION

After a short maceration, the grapes are softly pressed, the juice is clarified, and it undergoes the fermentation at the temperature of 18°C. The new wine is subsequently re-fermented in stainless steel pressure tanks.

Alcohol content: 11% vol

Acidity: 5,6 g/l

Residual sugar: 8 g/l

ORGANOLEPTIC DESCRIPTION

Straw yellow in colour with greenish highlights; pleasant typically aromatic bouquet of peach and musk rose.

The taste is fresh and effervescent, of medium body.

SERVING RECOMMENDATIONS

This is a wine very appealing to modern taste, being elegant with moderate alcohol. It is perfect for social drinking, as an aperitif and goes well with appetizers. Drink lightly chilled (10-12° C).

Contains sulphites.
